

A colouring-in game for two people. Can you fill adjacent hearts in different colours?

You need: six pencils in different colours and four dice (or roll online).

Before Playing

- Fill each of these dice in a different colour.
- Number the columns 1-3 and rows 4-6.
- Choose which player will fill in the outside of the hearts and which the inside.

How to Play

- 1. The player who chose the outside rolls the dice.
- 2. Each player chooses three of the four results and allocates them to a column, row, and colour.
- 3. Each player picks a blank heart in that column and row, and fills their part with that colour. The outside and inside of any heart must not be the same colour. The player who rolled colours first. Hearts which cross rows or columns count as either.

Repeat, with the other player rolling. Alternate who rolls, with both players choosing from the same four results. The rolling player always colours first. If the dice are all 1-3 or 4-6 and you can't pick a row or column, then re-roll all the dice. If one player can't fill in a heart then they miss the turn — potentially ending up with a blank heart.

How to Score

The game is over when one player has filled in all their hearts. (End of that turn, not instantly.)
Each player considers only their parts of the hearts when scoring.

Score one point for each colour used (up to 6). Minus one point for every blank heart. One point for each filled heart which does NOT share a space (i.e. the same row and column) with a heart of the same colour. Highest score wins.
